3. The book of Job isn't about Job; it's about God.
4. **Job 40:6**
 - a) "*whirlwind*" - a violent or destructive force.
5. Vs 7 Cf. 38:3

2) That God is sovereign over **Family**.

3) That God is sovereign over **Health**.

a) Job thought He had a handle on knowledge of God.

b) **Romans 11:33-34**

4. **John 21:25**

5. Vs 5

6. To "*see God*" is to "*Experience God*"

7. But the question is this: "*Have you experienced God personally?*"

d) Do your children bear the fruits of righteousness?

a) Do your kids *love God's Word*?

b) Do your children *love Church*?

c) Do your children *serve*?

d) Have they followed the Lord in believer's Baptism?

e) **PARENTS IS CHRIST IMPORTANT TO YOU?**
