### WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU'VE MADE A BAD DECISION

- I. USE GODLY WISDOM IN THE MIDST OF YOUR BAD DECISION
  - 1. **VERY IMPORTANT:** You don't have to continue making dumb decisions after you've made a dumb decision.
  - 2 Vs 14-15
  - 3. Vs 16-21
  - 4. Vs 22-27
  - 5 NOTICE THE IMPACT:
    - a) Gibeon is about 9-10 miles NW of Jerusalem.
    - b) Gibeon is the city of the Gibeonites and now becomes a Levitical City, and many
    - of the Priests of Israel lived there.
    - c) King David then sets up the tabernacle in Gibeon.
    - d) One of King Davids mighty men of valor was a Gibeonite.
    - e) 1 kings 3:5; 9:2
    - f) 2 Chronicles 1:3, 13
  - 6. Nehemiah 3:7
    - a) The son of Gibeon helped to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem in Nehemiah's day.
  - 7. 2 Samuel 21:1-3

8. The point here is to honor the bad decisions we have made and look for Godly solutions.

#### II. GOD WILL NEVER BE AT A LOSS BECAUSE OF YOUR BAD DECISIONS

- 1. Your bad decisions do not tie the hands of God.
- 2. **KEY**: Our bad decisions do not thwart the plans of God.
- 3. Chapter 10 Now notice what God does on their behalf.
- 4. **VERY IMPORTANT**: Everything in Chapter 10 could have been avoided if they would have been obedient.
  - a) No Wisdom
  - b) No Discernment
  - c) No Prayer
- 5. Vs 1-2
- 6. Vs 3-5
- 7. Vs 5-6
  - a) What would your response be here? (I finally got my chance)
- 8. Vs 7-11
  - a) Joshua honors his covenant!!

## III. WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU MAKE A BAD DECISION (Three things)

- A. TRUST THE PROMISE OF GOD
  - 1. Vs 8
    - a) "Do not fear them, for I have given them into your hands."
    - b) "Not a man of them shall stand before you."
  - 2.1 John 1:9
- B. ACT ON GOD'S PLAN
  - 1. Vs 9

- 2. **Vs 10** (Notice 4 verbs and Notice God is the subject of the verbs)
  - a) "And the LORD threw them into a panic before Israel"
  - b) "who struck them with a great blow at Gibeon"
  - c) "and *chased* them by the way of the ascent of Beth-horon"
  - d) "and struck them as far as Azekah and Makkedah."

- 4. Vs 11
- A. WE ARE TO ONCE AGAIN TRUST THE PROMISES OF GOD
- B. WE ARE TO ACT ON GOD'S PLAN TO MAKE THINGS RIGHT
- C. WE ARE TO GIVE OURSELVES TO GOD IN PRAYER
  - 1. Vs 12-13
  - 2. So what really happened? Only God knows!!!
    - a) Did the sun actually stop spinning?
    - b) Did God merely reflect the sun's rays?
    - c) Was it artificial light?
