#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- 2. **Joshua 20** (It now all becomes a reality)

- 6. Joshua 20:1-3
  - a) "They shall be for you a refuge from the avenger of blood."
    - 1) The "Avenger of Blood" was usually the next of kin kinsman redeemer or "blood redeemer."

### THREE IMPORTANT FACT ABOUT THE CITIES OF REFUGE

# I. THE <u>INITIATION</u> OF THE CITIES OF REFUGE

- 1. Notice Joshua 20:1
  - a) "Then the LORD said to Joshua.."
- 2. Only in Christianity do we have a "refuge" where we can run to.
- 3. God established 6 "Cities of Refuge" for those in Canaan Land. For the case of accidental deaths.
- 4. Vs 4-5
- 5. Exodus 21:14
- 6. Vs 6
- 7. The city of refuge was set up in such a way that you just didn't run into one and you were "safe".
  - a) No...there were 2 Court Style situations set up to determine guilt or innocence.

- 8. These "Cities of Refuge" were established so that an innocent man could run into a place of refuge and be protected from the "Avenger of Blood."
- 9. So what does this have to do with us?
  - a) You and I are guilty of murder!!!!!
  - b) You and I have sinned against a Holy God and it was and is intentional!!!
  - c) OUR SIN SENT AN INNOCENT MAN TO HIS EXECUTION!!!
- 10. IN THE OLD TESTAMENT ONLY THE INNOCENT COULD RUN TO THE CITY OF REFUGE AND FIND SAFETY.
- 11. BUT IN THE NEW TESTAMENT JESUS MY REFUGE GOES FURTHER
- 12. **Ephesians 1:4**

### II. THE INCLUSION OF THE CITIES OF REFUGE

- A. THE <u>ACCESSIBILITY</u> OF THE CITIES OF REFUGE
  - 1. Vs 9
    - a) "The people of Israel"
    - b) "AND for the stranger sojourning among them"
  - 2. Romans 10:13
- B. THE AVAILABILITY OF THE CITIES OF REFUGE
  - 1. Every city had walls and gates for protection and to keep the enemy out.
  - 2. 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, they were available.
- C. THE APPLICABILITY OF THE CITIES OF REFUGE
  - 1. **Vs 7** (On the west side of the Jordan)
    - a) "Kadesh" means "holy"
      - 1) 2 Corinthians 5:21
    - b) "Sheckim" means shoulder
      - 1) 2 Corinthians 12:8-10
    - c) "Kiriath-arba" (Hebron) = fellowship

- 1) Psalm 122:1
- 2. **Vs 8** (Now on the east side of the Jordan they designated:)
  - a) "Bezer" which means "fortification"
    1) Psalm 18:1-3
  - b) "Ramoth" means "to be lifted up"

    1) Psalm 40:1-3
  - c) "Golan" means separation
    1) 2 Corinthians 6:17
    - 2) 1 Corinthians 6:20

## III. THE INSTRUCTIONS GETTING TO THE CITIES OF REFUGE Vs 3-6

## A. THE ROADS TO THE CITIES WERE TO BE CLEARLY MARKED

- 1. The roads had to be clearly marked "Refuge"
- 2. Jewish writers say that the roads leading to these cities were always kept in good repair and that guide posts were place at every crossroad with "Refuge".

# B. THE ROADS TO THE CITIES WERE TO BE CLEARED OF DEBRIS

- 1. There had to be smooth passage to these cities.
- 2. When there was an "Avenger of Blood" in hot pursuit...the innocent party had to get to "Refuge" without hindrance.

### C. THE ROADS TO THESE CITIES WERE AIDED BY RUNNERS

1. These "Runners" were 2 students of the Law who were stationed at certain places on the road to make sure the innocent party would get to the "City of Refuge."
