### I. THE NATURE OF PEACE

### A. THE OBJECTIVE NATURE OF PEACE

- 1. Objective peace has to do with your relationship with God.
- 2. Romans 5:10a
  - a) "For if while we were the enemies of God."
- 3. John 3:36

- 5. 2 Corinthians 5:18-20
  - a) **Reconciliation** is the act of God where-by He does away with the hostility between the Gospel believer and establishes peace.
- 6. This peace is objective truth and has nothing to do with how we feel...it is a fact.

## B. THE SUBJECTIVE NATURE OF PEACE

- 1. John 14:27
- 2. This is experiential peace...this is tranquility of the soul.
- 3. Romans 8:32
- 4. Philippians 4:7
  - a) "and the peace of God"
  - b) "which surpasses understanding"
    - 1) It transcends human intellectual powers.
    - 2) It is beyond human solutions.
    - 3) It is a calm that lifts the believer above the most debilitating trial.
  - c) "will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus"
    - 1) "guard" means to stand @ post and guard against aggression of the enemy.
    - 2) This is the kind of peace men really want.
      - a) Who wants the past to steal your peace?
      - b) Who wants the **present** to steal your peace?
      - c) Who wants fear of the future to steal your peace?

# II. THE AUTHORITY OF PEACE

- 1. The "Peace of God" is not obtainable by those who are not at "Peace with God."

  - a) "my peace I give to you"
- 6. Jesus gives us His own personal peace.

## III. THE DISPENSER OF PEACE

- 1. *Galatians* 5:22
  - a) "the Fruit of the Spirit"
- 2. Here's a question for you: If it is Jesus peace...than why is the Holy Spirit giving it?
- 3. Answer: John 16:12-15
- 4. The Holy Spirit's ministry is to glorify Christ.

### IV. THE DISTINCTION OF PEACE

- 1. John 14:27
  - a) "Not as the world gives do I give to you"
- 2. The peace the world gives, is shallow and unfulfilling.
- 3. ILLUSTRATION: Worldly drug rehab centers have a very low success rate.
- 4. Most people's pursuit of peace is to get away from problems.
- 5. That's why people seek alcohol and drugs. It's an escape!!!
- 6. Fact is; that apart from God there is no real peace in this world.
- 7. Sure it's possible to know momentary tranquility that is stimulated by positive circumstances mixed with a lot of ignorance. **WORLD PEACE IS A LIE**.
- 8. But if a lost man only knew:
  - a) Jeremiah 17:9
  - b) Isaiah 48:22
- 9. KNOW JESUS ---- KNOW PEACE NO JESUS ---- NO PEACE

## V. THE <u>DECISION</u> OF PEACE

- 1. John 14:27
  - a) "Do not let your heart be troubled"
- 2. Peace is a decision. It is ours for the taking.
- 3. The peace Jesus gives is to be believed, received and applied to our lives.
- 4. If you have a troubled heart...it is because you do not believe God.
- 5. Colossians 3:15
  - a) "rule" means to act as an umpire
- 6. We are to be so dependent on Christ that He becomes an umpire in the decisions we have to make in life.
- 7. We are to let the peace of Christ make decisions for us.
- 8. Look again @ Colossians 3:15
  - a) Peace is foundational to Christian unity.
- 9. 2 Corinthians 4:8-11; 16-18
