      - 2) Never did God so manifest His hatred for sin as in the suffering and death of His own Son.

- 2. Notice four things that made Peter fail the test of faithfulness.
  - a) He ran his mouth too much.
    - 1) John 13:37
    - 2) Luke 22:31-32
  - b) He didn't pray enough
    - 1) Luke 22:44-46
    - 2) Notice what Peter wrote years later: 1 Peter 4:7
  - c) He acted without thinking
    - 1) Luke 22:50
    - 2) God's will is not always easy to accept, but those who are truly loyal will be sensitive to what it is.
    - 3) Peter thought he was helping but was totally oblivious to what God was doing.
  - d) He followed at a distance
    - 1) Luke 22:54
      - a) He was a coward
    - 2) Luke 22:55
      - a) Peter was sitting with the ones who had seized Jesus.
    - 3) Luke 22:56
    - 4) Luke 22:57-62
