#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- 1. WE must never fear conflict....because change is inevitable, so is conflict.
  - Change will occur whether you EMBRACE it or not.
  - AND when you fear conflict you don't ever want to see change.
- 2. From **Joshua 1 to Joshua 22** we have covered about  $7\frac{1}{2}$  years and 31 battles.

TWO THINGS THAT ARE VITAL TO KNOW IN THE MIDST OF CHANGE

- I. IN THE MIDST OF CHANGE THERE ARE THINGS THAT MUST NEVER CHANGE
  - 1. Joshua 21:44-45
  - 2. Vs 44
    - a) "rest" does not mean the absence of activity!!!
  - 3. JESUS DID NOT GO TO THE CROSS SO WE WOULD DO NOTHING.

FIVE ABSOLUTE FOUNDATIONAL TRUTHS THAT NEVER CHANGE

A. NEVER CHANGE YOUR ALLEGIANCE TO GOD'S WORD

  - a) "observe the commandment and the law of Moses"

#### B. NEVER CHANGE YOUR COMMITMENT TO WORSHIP

  - a) "to love the Lord your God"
- 2. Luke 10:27
  - a) "You shall love the Lord your God..."
    - 1) "with all your heart"
      - a) Emotions
    - 2) "with all your soul"
      - a) Your person...who you are.
    - 3) "with all your strength"
      - a) In your physical body.
    - 4) "with all your mind"
      - a) Your intellect

## C. NEVER CHANGE YOUR COMMITMENT TO A GODLY WALK

- 1. Vs 5c
  - a) "to walk in all his ways"
    - 1) "walk" refers to our lifestyle

## D. NEVER CHANGE YOUR COMMITMENT TO GOD'S WILL FOR YOUR LIFE

- 1. Vs 5d
  - a) "to cling to Him"
    - 1) "cling" means to hold on, to grab onto, to cleave.

## E. NEVER CHANGE YOUR COMMITMENT TO HIS WORK

- 1. Vs 5e
  - a) "and to serve him"
