 - 1) "establish" means to be fixed or secured, it's firm.
 - b) "blameless in holiness"
 - 1) "blameless" means without blame, faultless,
 - 2) "holiness" a separated life that can be seen by others.
 - c) "before our God and Father"
 - 1) "before" means "in front of"
- 3. We are to grow in Sanctification!!
 - a) We are set apart and reserved for God's glory.
 - b) 1 Corinthians 6:20
- 4. In 4:1-12 Paul deals with the doctrine of Sanctification.

I. WHAT HOLY LIVING DOES

- A. IT PLEASES GOD
 - 1 Vs 1-3a
- B. IT PROGRESSES
 - 1. Vs 1b
 - a) "that you do so more and more"
- C. IT KEEPS US PURE
 - 1. Vs 3b
 - a) "that you abstain from sexual immorality"
 - 1) "abstain" means to keep oneself from. To refrain.

- a) "Make War"
- 3. Vs 6
 - a) "because the Lord is the avenger in all these things"
 - 1) "avenger" God is the avenger of the one who wrongs his brother.
 - a) "vengeance" punishment inflicted in retaliation for an injury or offense.
- 4. Vs 7
 - a) WOW!!!! Why?
 - 1) Cf. 1:2-10
- D. IT KEEPS US ACCOUNTABLE
 - 1. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
- E. IT TRANSFORMS US
 - 1. Vs 5
 - a) "who do not know God"
- F. IT GIVES US A TESTIMONY
 - 1. Vs 11a
 - a) "and to aspire to live quietly"
 - 2. Vs 11b
 - a) "and to mind your own affairs"
 - 3. Vs 11c
 - a) "and to work with your own hands"
 - 4.1 Peter 3:15

II. MOTIVES FOR HOLY LIVING

- A. GOD COMMANDS IT
 - 1. Vs 1, 2
 - 2. Vs 3
 - a) "It's the will of God"
 - 3. No better reason than that!
 - 4. Vs 7

- 5. **Vs 8** Wow!!
 - a) "Therefore whoever disregards this"
 - 1) "disregard" means to pay no attention to treat as unworthy of notice
 - b) "disregards not man, but God"
 - c) "who gives his Holy Spirit to you"
- 6. Matthew 5:48
 - a) "Be ye perfect"

B. BECAUSE IT'S A CALLING

- 1. We cannot be moral and impure and expect the Holy Spirit to manifest His fruit in and through us.
- 2. Robert Murray McCheyne, the 19th century Scottish preacher said, "Lord God, make me as holy as it is possible for a redeemed sinner to be."

C. BECAUSE IT COMPELLS US

- 1. The world expects more out of us.
- 2. WOW!!! It is Satan's delight when Christians fail.
- 3. James 1:15
- 4. Vs 12
 - a) "so that you may walk properly before outsiders"
 - 1) "properly" decently
 - b) *Colossians* 4:5-6
 - c) 1 Timothy 3:7

III. THE METHOD OF A HOLY LIFE

- 1. Someone once said, "The Christian life is not a difficult life; it is an impossible life."
- 2. Vs 8
 - a) "who gives his Holy Spirit to you"

3. A person wholly separated to Christ will be controlled by the Holy Spirit.

a) The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

- 1) Galatians 3:27-28
 - a. This is where the Gospel believer is placed "in Christ"
 - b. Baptism means to be immersed or placed into.
- 2) Some people teach that there is a second work of grace.
 - a. That the baptism of the Holy Spirit is a reoccurring event.
 - b. But the baptism of the Holy Spirit occurs one time in the believers life and this at the moment of Salvation.
 - c. 1 Corinthians 12:13
 - d. Galatians 3:27
- b) The Filling of the Holy Spirit
 - 1) Ephesians 5:18
 - 2) The question is not "How much of the Holy Spirit do you have???"

 The question is "How much of you does the Holy Spirit have???"
 - 3) It's a matter of CONTROL.

- 5. We must be "filled" with the Spirit every day.
