### "The Importance of Holiness"

#### 1 Thessalonians 4:1-12 Part 1

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- 1. The church was planted during Paul's second missionary journey.
  - a) Paul, Silas and Timothy came there.
  - b) Acts 17:1-14
- 2.2:17-20
- 3. The Believers @ Thessalonica were "Contagious Christians"
  - a) 1:1-10
- 4. They were faithful in the Gospel
  - a) 2:1-12
- 5. They were faithful in the midst of trials.
  - a) 3:1-13
  - b) 2 kinds of faith
    - 1) The "if" kind
    - 2) The "though" kind
- 6. **VERY IMPORTANT**: As Christians we must be very careful of redefining God to fit our own agenda.
  - a) We redefine when we don't stay focused on facts.
  - b) ILLUSTRATION: Transgender Woman Breaks Women's Powerlifting Records
- 7. As Christians we must be careful not to redefine God's standards.
  - a) When we do that we redefine sex, marriage, Family
  - b) BUT GOD DOES NOT CHANGE
  - c) We call this the Immutability of God.
    - 1) Psalm 119:89
- 8. **Church** "Gradually the unthinkable becomes tolerable, then acceptable, then legal, then praised."
- 9. Very Important: God's fundamental attribute is His holiness!!!
  - a) Isaiah 6 the Seraphim said "Holy, Holy, Holy" not "Love, Love, Love"
  - b) BUT GOD'S LOVE FLOWS FROM HIS HOLINESS

- 10. Notice 3:13
  - a) "establish your hearts" to be fixed or firm
  - b) "blameless in holiness" -
  - c) "before" only God know the true intentions of your heart.
- 11. WOW!!! It is possible for Christians to redefine who God is!!!
  - a) Jeremiah 17:9
    - 1) You are 100% bad.
- 12. In Chapter 4 Paul focuses on "The Importance of Holiness"
- 13. In 4:1-12 Paul deals with the doctrine of Sanctification.
  - a) Justification is when we get saved. We are then declared righteous.
  - b) Sanctification means that because of our Sanctification we are set apart and reserved for God and His glory.
    - 1) 1 Corinthians 6:20
  - c) Glorification when we are in the presence of God and the war is over.
- 14. Now there are 3 tenses of Sanctification.
  - a) Past (Positional)
    - 1) 4:7
  - b) **Present** (Progressive)
    - 1) 4:3
  - c) **Future** (Perfect)
    - 1) 3:13, 4:13-18

# I. WHAT HOLY LIVING DOES

- A. IT PLEASES GOD
  - 1. Vs 1
    - a) "walk" is your lifestyle
  - 2. Vs 2
  - 3. **Vs 3a** 
    - a) "For this is the will of God"
    - b) "you're sanctification"
  - 4. Romans 12:1-2

### B. IT PROGRESSES

- 1. Vs 1b
  - a) "how you ought to walk and please God"
  - b) Wow!!! "just as you are doing, that you do more and more"
- 2. Philippians 1:6
  - a) God is at work in every believer.

# C. KEEPS US PURE

- 1. Vs 3b
  - a) "that you abstain from sexual immorality"
- 2. QUESTION: So what exactly is God for?
- 3. 2 Areas of impurity that we need to correct:
  - a) The Physical Aspect
    - 1) Vs 4
      - a. Again this may very well be the first time these Christians heard this standard.
  - b) The Mental Aspect
    - 1) Vs 5
      - a. "The passion of lust"
        - Thoughts
        - Movies
        - Pornography
        - Magazines
      - b. All a violation of God's standard of separation.
      - c. James 1:12-15
- 4. THE WARNING: Vs 6
  - a) "because the Lord is an avenger in all such things"

# D. IT KEEPS US ACCOUNTABLE

- 1. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
- 2. Romans 6:13

# E. IT TRANSFORMS US

- 1. Vs 5
  - a) "who do not know God"
- 2. Paul's point: If we live ungodly lives redefining what God has said, we look just like those who don't know God.

# F. IT GIVES US A TESTIMONY

- 1. To live <u>humbly</u>
  - a) **Vs 11a** 
    - 1) "aspire to live quietly"
  - b) **Vs 11b** 
    - 1) "and to mind your own affairs"
  - c) Vs 11c
    - 1) "and to work with your hands"
- 2. To live honestly
  - a) Vs 12
  - b) An honest person is transparent, keeps his promises, and is responsible.
