- 1. Where do we get the term "Rapture"?
 - a) 1 Thessalonians 4:17
 - 1) "will be caught up"
 - b) The term "Rapture" is Latin for the phrase "caught up"
- 2. So what's the difference between the "Rapture" and the "Second Coming"? (Here are some differences)
 - a) The "Place" where Christ comes.
 - 1) In the Rapture, Christ comes in the clouds.
 - a. 4:17
 - 2) In the **Second Coming**, Christ comes to earth on the Mount of Olives.
 - a. Zechariah 14:2-4
 - b) The "Timing" of these events.
 - 1) The Rapture takes place Before the Tribulation. Daniel's 70th week.
 - a. Revelation 3:10
 - b. 1 Thessalonians 1:10
 - c. 1 Thessalonians 5:9
 - 2) In the Second Coming, Christ comes after the Tribulation.
 - a Matthew 24:29-30
 - b. Daniel 9:26-27
 - c) The "Resurrection" of Believers
 - 1) The Church Saints
 - a. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-18
 - 2) The Tribulation Saints
 - a. Revelation 20:1-5
 - d) The "Execution" of Judgment
 - 1) The Rapture
 - a. 1 Corinthians 3:10-15
 - b. Christ does not judge the earth.
 - 2) The Second Coming

a. 2 Thessalonians 1:1-8

- b. Jesus comes in vengeance
- 3. WE MUST UNDERSTAND THE **PURPOSE** OF THE **TRIBULATION**.
- 4. Daniel 9:24-27
- 5. Vs 24
 - a) "70 weeks" 70 units of 7 or 490 years
 - b) "are determined" means fixed and cannot be altered
 - c) "on thy people" Israel
 - d) "thy holy city" Jerusalem
 - e) "to finish the transgression" rebellion and remove apostacy
 - f) "to make an end of sin" That is the forgiveness of sin.
 - 1) The Jewish people must embrace the Cross.
 - 2) Romans 11:20-27
 - g) "to make reconciliation" to make peace
 - h) "to bring in everlasting righteousness" in the millennial kingdom
 - 1) Isaiah 60:21
 - 2) Jeremiah 23:5-6
 - i) "to seal up the vision and prophecy" the fulfillment of all prophecy
 - j) "to anoint the most holy" Christ on the throne
- 6. **Vs 25** (The Division of the Weeks)
 - a) "Know therefore and understand"
 - b) "that from the going out of the word to restore and build Jerusalem to the coming of an anointed one a prince"
 - c) "there shall be seven weeks"
 - 1) "seven weeks"
 - a. 49 years 7 units of 7
 - d) "then for 62 weeks it shall be built again"

- 7. So we have 7 weeks + 62 weeks = 69 weeks of years = 483 years
- 8. The decree to rebuild Jerusalem happened on March 14, 445 BC.
 - a) Nehemiah 2:1-8
- 9. Therefore 483 years from March 14, 445 BC Christ was crucified.
- 10. 69 weeks have been fulfilled with 1 week left (Daniel's 70th week) still yet to be fulfilled.
- 11. 70 weeks are determined upon thy people!!!! Israel

I. A PREVIEW OF THE RAPTURE

A. INFORMING THE UNINFORMED

- 1. Vs 13
 - a) "But we do not want you to be uninformed (ignorant)"

B. A <u>DISCRIPTION</u> OF DEATH FOR THE <u>BELIEVER</u>

- 1. Vs 13
 - a) "about those who are asleep"
 - 1) "sleep" gk. Koimas metaphorical
 - 2) John 11:11
 - 3) Acts 7:6
 - 4) Acts 13:36
- 2. Our word "cemetery" is taken from the gk. Word "koimeteria" which means sleeping place.
- 3. 2 Corinthians 5:8
- 4. For those who are "in Christ" @ the Rapture their bodies will be resurrected "awakened" and united with their souls.
- 5. The Greek term "koimao" is never used for sleep of the soul, only the body.
- 6. Vs 13
 - a) "that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope"
