LIVING WITHOUT FEAR BECAUSE OF THE RESURRECTION

MATTHEW 28:1-15

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Many people fear **DEATH**.
- 2. Many people fear **WASTING** their life.
 - a. The **DISCIPLES** were hiding in fear
 - b. The **RELIGIOUS LEADERS** were planning because of fear. (Mt. 27:62-66)
 - c. The **WOMEN** approached the tomb in fear. (Mt. 28:1-10)

LIVING WITHOUT FEAR BECAUSE OF THE RESURRECTION

A. THE SAVIOR IS <u>ALIVE</u> (vv.1-10)

- i. "for He has risen" (v.6)
- ii. If Jesus is still in the tomb, we have no hope. (1 Cor. 15:17-19)
- iii. Because Jesus is alive, we have a living hope. (1 Peter 1:3-5)

- **B.** YOUR SINS CAN BE <u>FORGIVEN</u> (v.5)
 - i. "..you seek Jesus who was crucified" (v.5)
 - ii. God's love for you sent Jesus to the cross. (Romans 5:8)
 - iii. Jesus' death on the cross paid your sin debt. (Hebrews 10:12-13)

- **B.** YOUR SINS CAN BE <u>FORGIVEN</u> (v.5)(CONTINUED)
 - iv. Jesus' resurrection is evidence that his death was sufficient to pay for your sins. (Romans 4:25)
 - v. Salvation from sin is free gift received by faith. (Eph. 2:8, 9)
 - vi. Your faith must be in the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. (1 Cor. 15:1-4)

C. THE SCRIPTURES CAN BE TRUSTED (v.6)

- i. "as he said" everything happened as Jesus said it would.
- ii. "Jesus is either a liar, a lunatic, or He is Lord." C.S. Lewis

THE WRONG TOMB THEORY

- THE WOMEN AND DISCIPLES WERE SO GRIEF STRICKEN THAT THEY
 WENT TO THE WRONG TOMB, AN EMPTY TOMB, AND MISTAKENLY
 CONCLUDED THAT JESUS HAD RISEN FROM THE DEAD.
- PROBLEMS: RELIGIOUS LEADERS WOULD HAVE WENT TO THE CORRECT TOMB WHERE THE SOLDIERS WERE LOCATED AND PRODUCED THE BODY. THEY COULD ALSO LOCATE JOSEPH OF ARIMATHEA WHO OWNED THE TOMB WHERE JESUS WAS BURIED.

THE SWOON THEORY

- JESUS DIDN'T ACTUALLY DIE ON THE CROSS. HE WENT INTO A DEATH-LIKE COMA, HE REVIVED WHEN LAID IN THE COOL TOMB, WALKED OUT.
- PROBLEMS: JESUS WAS BRUTALLY TORTURED, CRUCIFIED, STABBED IN THE SIDE, WRAPPED IN LINEN CLOTHS, SEALED IN A TOMB WITH A STONE WEIGHING ANYWHERE FROM 500-2000LBS. GUARDS WERE POSTED OUTSIDE THE TOMB.

THE JESUS LEGEND THEORY

- THE HISTORICAL JESUS AND THE BIBLICAL JESUS ARE NOT THE SAME. THE BIBLICAL JESUS IS A MYTH THAT GREW OVER TIME.
- PROBLEMS: LEGENDS TAKE TIME TO DEVELOP AND THE CHURCH GREW
 MASSIVELY AND QUICKLY FOLLOWING THE RESURRECTION; OVER 500 EYES
 WITNESSES COULD VERIFY THEY SAW JESUS; PAUL WAS A DEVOUT PHARISEE
 AND PERSECUTOR OF THE CHURCH WHO JUST MIRACULOUSLY CHANGED HIS
 MIND OVER NIGHT. IN THE GOSPEL ACCOUNTS WOMEN WERE USED AS
 WITNESSES WHICH WOULD NOT HAVE HELD UP IN THAT CULTURE.

THE STOLEN BODY CONSPIRACY THEORY (V.11-15)

- THE DISCIPLES STOLE THE BODY OF JESUS AND SAID HE ROSE FROM THE GRAVE.
- PROBLEMS: THE DISCIPLES HAD NOTHING TO GAIN EXCEPT TORTURE AND DEATH. WHY WOULD THEY SUFFER/DIE FOR A LIE? THE SOLDIERS WERE HIGHLY TRAINED AND TO LOSE THE BODY WAS A CAPITAL OFFENCE PUNISHABLE BY DEATH. OH...AND THE GUARDS WERE <u>ASLEEP</u> BUT <u>SAW</u> THE DISCIPLES STEAL THE BODY????
