VICTORIOUS SPIRITUAL WARFARE

"Satan Is A Defeated Foe"

Job 1: Luke 22: 2 Corinthians 12

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Satan has been a loser from all the ages since his rebellion.
 - a) One day he will taste his eternal defeat @ the hands of Jesus in the eternal Lake of Fire.

WHAT SATAN'S DEFEAT LOOKS LIKE

I. SATAN HAS BEEN DEFEATED <u>DECISIVELY</u>

A. IT'S A NO CONTEST

- 1. Satan was created!!!
 - a) And he rebelled against God who created him.
- 2. Ezekiel 28:11-13

B. TEMPORARY INSANITY

- 1. The devil uses Optical Illusions against us to get us to think he's bigger and more powerful than he really is.
- 2. An Optical Illusion is something that plays tricks on your eyes.
 - a) An Optical Illusion can use color, light, and patterns to create images that can be deceptive or misleading to our brains.

C. USING SATAN FOR GLORY

- 1. Instead of God obliterating Satan, God uses Satan and his rebellion to being God more glory.
- 2. **THIS IS BIG**: God is using Satan to bring Himself more glory than He would have had.....if Satan's rebellion had not occurred.
- 3. LOOK AT JOB Job 1:1-5
 - a) Vs 6-12
 - 1) OUCH So God "invited" Satan to consider Job.
 - b) Satan was going to put Job's faith to the test!!!
 - 1) But he had to get God's permission.

- 4. God knew Job would hold firm and honor Him in spite of severe testing, and in doing so...Job's life brought God more glory than it would have.
 - 1) God will permit Satan to test us too.
- 5. It's not always easy to keep your focus on God.
 - a) Job 1:21
 - 1) "Blessed be the name of the Lord"
 - b) Job 2:10
 - c) Job 13:15
 - 1) "I will hope in Him"
- 6. BIG: The focus for job was not what Satan did, but what God could do.
- 7. LOOK AT PETER: Luke 22:31-34
 - a) Satan asked for permission to get after Peter.
 - 1) Why??? Because Peter got proud.
 - b) Satan wasted no time but got right to work!!
 - 1) Vs 33
- 8. God gave Satan permission to test Peter severely because He knew that when Peter "turned again" and repented, he was going to be a greater minister on God's behalf.
- 9. LOOK AT PAUL 2 Corinthians 12:7-9, 10
 - a) Paul struggled with pride.

II. SATAN'S DEFEAT PREDICTED

• Genesis 3:15

A. SATAN'S DECLARATION

- 1. Isaiah 14
 - a) Satan's 5 "I will" declarations.
- 2. The devil declared what he was going to attempt to do.
- 3. In **Genesis 3:15**
 - a) Here God declares an "I will" of His own.
- 4. God said He would put enmity (strife) between the woman's seed and the serpent's seed.

- 5. Notice how the conflict unfolds.
 - a) **Genesis 3:15** indicates that God's victory would not come without suffering.
 - 1) "thou shalt bruise His heal"
 - b) Genesis 3:15
 - 1) "He shall bruise thy head"

B. SATAN'S VENGEANCE

- 1. Genesis 4:1-2
- 2. When Abel was born, Satan probably thought Abel was the righteous seed who would crush his head.
- 3. Vs 3-8
 - a) God accepted Abel's offering and rejected Cain's.
- 4.1 John 3:12
- 5. Deuteronomy 29:29
- 6. God always has the last word.
 - a) Even though Satan got Cain to kill Abel in attempt to get rid of God's righteous seed, God had something Satan wasn't counting on.

C. GOD ALWAYS WINS

- 1. Genesis 4:25-26
- 2. Seth was God's substitute for Abel.
 - a) Vs 26
- 3. God had someone else ready to take Abel's place.
 - a) God always has someone else ready to step up and take an Abel's place.
- 4. Satan messed up because he didn't know that God had a plan.
