### THE LIFE OF ELIJAH

# "Circle of Provision"

## 1 Kings 17:8-16

#### INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Once Elijah made it through the first phase of Boot Camp @ Camp Cherith...
  - a) God would move Elijah to more advanced training @ Zarephath.
- 2. We need to understand that the term "deeper" is not abnormal but the reality God desires of all those who LOVE HIM!!
  - a) God wants us to venture out from the shallow waters and submerse ourselves deeper.
    - 1) Deeper in the Word
      - a. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 KJV
      - c. **Psalm 119**
    - 2) Deeper in Prayer
      - a. "Pray in the Spirt" -
    - 3) Deeper in Worship
      - a. John 4:23-24
    - 4) Deeper in Faith
      - a. Learn fearless Faith
      - b. To learn Patience
      - c. To trust God's Provision
      - d. Trust that God was in Control Isaiah 55:8-9
- 3. God took Elijah deeper so Elijah would be prepared to accomplish deeper things.
- 4. John 14:15
  - a) "If you love me"
- 5.1 Corinthians 2:9
  - a) That's a promise to be claimed!!!
- 6. John 21:15-17
  - a) Matthew 16:13-19
  - b) Acts 1:8
- 7. KEY Elijah loved God 1 Kings 17:1-5
- 8. Vs 6-7
- 9. Once Elijah made it through the rigors of Camp Cherith, an even more demanding time of testing awaited Elijah @ Zarephath.
  - a) Because God knew what awaited Elijah.

- 10. Vs 8-9
- 11. Zarephath means "to melt"
- 12. Zarephath would be a "Crucible" for Elijah.
- 13. **REMEMBER THIS**: Crucibles create Christlikeness.
  - a) "How Firm a Foundation"
    - 1) That's what the refiner's fire does.
  - b) That's what going deeper does.
    - 1) It creates greater purity.

## I. GOD HAS A PLAN

- 1. God knows what the future holds for Elijah!!
  - a) Elijah does not!!!
- 2. God knows the strength Elijah will need if he's going to stand strong.
  - a) Ephesians 6:10-13
- 3. Charlie Kirk from Turning Point USA said:

"Time is running thin and we don't have time for gutless wonders. We must speak the truth in love!"

- 4. Zarephath was the homeland of Jezebel and the heart of Baal Worship!!!
  - a) It was the Baal Belt.....like the Bible Belt

## A. GOD KNOWS WHERE WE ARE

- 1. There will always be times when we will feel forsaken and forgotten.
  - a) That's why we need to be drenched in God's Word.
  - b) Isaiah 41:10
- 2. That's another PROMISE of GOD!!!
  - a) When we go deeper we will need to hold tight to God's Promises.

# B. GOD KNOWS WHERE WE ARE GOING

- 1. How gracious for God to lead Elijah one step at a time!!
  - a) That's what He does with us.
- 2. **Vs 7-8**
- 3. When did the word of the Lord come to Elijah?
  - a) When the Brook dried up!!!

- 4. Vs 9
  - a) "Arise, go"
  - b) "Zarephath" Was located far to the west, on the coast of the Mediterranean approx. 100 miles from Cherith.
  - c) "And dwell there"
    - 1) "dwell" literally means to sit down or stay put.

#### 5. Cf. 18:4

- a) Elijah was a wanted man...he literally had a contract out on him.
  - 1) Ahab's Army was aggressively seeking Elijah's head!!
- 6. HERE'S THE KEY: Vs 2, 8
  - a) "And the word of the Lord came to him"
- 7. You better Make sure it's the LORD'S voice you hear!
  - a) Just remember God knows exactly where Elijah was going.

## C. GOD PROVIDES

- 1. Vs 9
  - a) "I have commanded a widow there to feed you"
    - 1) That ain't right!!
- 2. James 1:27
- 3. But instead God said the poor widow was going to provide for Elijah.
- 4. God is about to show Elijah that the most humbling tasks prepare us for greater tasks.
  - 1) I have no idea what God has for you in the future...BUT I do know that it will include some humbling experiences.
  - 2) Humility is a necessary part of God's plan.
  - 3) For Elijah humility would be a poor widow provide for his needs.

### II. RESPONDING TO GOD'S TESTS

#### A. A STRANGE TWIST

- 1. Elijah walked 100 miles from Cherith to Zarephath.
  - a) Through pagan hostile territory.
- 2. Vs 10
- 3. Vs 11

- 4. I am sure that Elijah went to Zarephath anticipating a little more provisions than @ Cherith.
  - a) You know the greater the sacrifice the greater the reward.
- 5. I am sure that Elijah was confused by his first IMPRESSION.
  - a) Vs 9-10

## B. SEEING PHYSICAL IMPOSSIBILITIES

- 1. GOD WAS ABOUT TO TEACH ELIJAH A LESSON ON FAITH
- 2. Vs 12
  - a) She didn't even go to church!!! "your God"
- 3. **HERE IT IS**: God was teaching Elijah that in order to be blessed you first need to be a blessing.
- 4. Vs 13-14
- 5. THE KEY TO ELIJAH'S SUCCESS WAS HIS OBEDIENCE
- 6. "You will never be able to light another's candle of hope if your own torch of faith isn't burning."
- 7. IMPORTANT: This is what's known as "God's supernatural circle of Provision!!!"
- 8 Vs 15-16
  - a) Elijah challenged the woman's faith in what God had said.
- 9. YES Man's obedience and God's faithfulness leads to miracles.
  - a) 1 Corinthians 2:9

- 1 Vs 16
- 2. We must go deeper!!!
  - a) "For without faith it is impossible to please Him!!"
- 3. When you come to the end of your own resources....remember God is your ONLY source.
