#### THE LIFE OF ELIJAH

"God Keeps His Promises"

## 1 Kings 18:41-46

#### INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The fact that God keeps His promises is a major part of the IMMUTABLE nature of God
  - a) Numbers 23:19
- 2. It was because of a promise of God that Elijah came on the scene in the first place.
  - a) 1 Kings 17:1
- 3. Even though it may seem like God has forgotten...He never forgets anything He promises. **NEVER**.
- 4. God assured Elijah, who passed it on to the king, that the drought would not end until God determined it would end. **PERIOD**..........BOOM
- 5. God keeps his promises!!!
  - a) God's word is always final!!!
- 6. God's agenda always continues to unfold right on schedule!!!
  - a) Even when we think He's forgotten.
  - b) Even in the most extreme events when life doesn't seem fair.
  - c) God is there carrying out His plan.
  - d) And God doesn't feel the need to clear any part of His plan with us!!
- 7.18:1
- 8.18:39
  - a) When God proved Himself to them, the "people fell on their faces" and immediately acknowledged, "The LORD He is God."

## I. CLARITY ABOUT PROMISES

- 1. Can we claim every promise PERSONALLY? NO
- 2. 2 Timothy 3:16
- A. PERSONAL OR <u>UNIVERSAL</u>?

- 1. We must ask "Is it a promise that was meant for a unique situation for a specific purpose God reserved for their time and place."
- 2. Or "Is it a promise with a universal appeal?"
  - a) Or did God intend it for anyone in any generation?
- 3. VERY IMPORTANT: If it is a universal promise that we can claim!!!
  - a) Claim it!!
  - b) Believe it!!
  - c) Memorize it!!

# 4. A PROMISE WE CANNOT CLAIM

- a) Joshua 6:3-5
- b) Mark 16:18
  - 1) **WOW!!!** It is dangerous to claim a promise out of context, away from its original meaning.

#### 5. EXAMPLE OF UNIVERSAL PROMISES

- a) Psalm 103:11-13
- b) **Proverbs 3:5-6**
- c) Isaiah 41:10
- d) Isaiah 40:31

### B. CONDITIONAL OR UNCONDITIONAL?

- 1. We must determine whether the PROMISE is CONDITIONAL or not.
  - a) A Conditional Promise will not be realized until we have kept our part.
    - 1) 1 Corinthians 2:9 (Go to verse)
    - 2) 1 John 2:9
    - 3) Matthew 21:22
      - a. Psalm 66:18
  - b) An Unconditional Promise has no conditions.
    - 1) Psalm 119:105
    - 2) Philippians 4:19
    - 3) Titus 2:11

- 2. The Bible is God's inspired truth.
  - a) It can be trusted because God can be trusted.
  - b) The Bible is our sacred guide!!

## II. ELIJAH <u>CLAIMS</u> GOD'S PROMISE

#### 1. WHAT GOD SAID WOULD HAPPEN!!! HAPPENED!!!

- a) The land had become dry and parched!!
- 2. 1 Kings 18:1
- 3. In Chapter 17 Elijah met that condition!!
  - a) He went to Ahab!!
  - b) Then he climbed to the top of Mount Carmel and prayed fire down from heaven.
  - c) Vs 39-40
- 4. 1 Kings 18:41
- 5. So what was the sound?
  - a) Elijah was certain that the rain was coming, not because he heard the sound of rain, but because he claimed God's promise.

#### III. LABORING IN PRAYER

1. 1 Kings 18:42-44

### FIVE PARTS OF ELIJAH'S PRAYER

### A. HE GOT ALONE

- 1 Vs 42
  - a) Elijah had a place to meet with God. Mount Carmel
- 2. We need a place where we where we can get alone with God to pray, to wait, to seek His will AND CLAIM HIS PROMISES.

# B. HE PERSEVERED IN PRAYER

- 1. Vs 42
  - a) "and he bowed himself down on the earth and put his face between his knees."
    - 1) WOW!!! That's a position of LABOR.

- 2. Elijah just came through the greatest victory of his life, was not arrogant but postured himself to labor in prayer.
- 3. 1 Peter 5:6

# C. HE WAS SPECIFIC

- 1. Vs 43
  - a) "Go up now"
  - b) "look toward the sea"
- 2. Look for rain!!!
  - a) Elijah expected rain.

# D. HE WAS PERSISTENT

- 1. Vs 43
- 2. Waiting is hard!!!
  - a) God is seldom early, but He is never late.
- 3. BUT GOD KEEPS HIS PROMISES.

# E. HE WAS EXPECTANT

- 1. Vs 44
- 2. Do you live expecting???
  - a) Do you imagine the improbable...expecting the impossible?
- 3. **VERY IMPORTANT**: Life is full and running over with opportunities to see God's hand at work in our lives.
- 4. Vs 45-46
- 5. James 5:16b-18
  - a) Elijah was just like us
