THE UNVEILING OF JESUS CHRIST

"The Church that Left It's First Love"

Revelation 2:1-7

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. We now begin in chapter 2 the second of the three sections of Revelation as outlined in Revelation 1:19.
 - a) Chapter 1 "The things which you have seen"
 - b) Chapter 4 "and those that are to take place after this"
 - c) Chapters 2 and 3 "those that are"
- 2. Golden Lampstand
 - a) Lampstand made from one piece of pure gold.
 - b) Lamps made of clay representing the churches and their humanity.
 - c) Oil represents the Holy Spirit who indwells the Lamps
 - d) **Wick** when lit represents the light of the Glorious Gospel which dispels the darkness and reflects the beauty of the Lampstand.
- 3. Chapter 1:9-11
- 4. Description of Christ Vs 12-13a
 - a) Vs 13
 - 1) "and in the midst of the lampstands, one like a son of man"
 - 2) "clothed with a long robe"
 - a. Speaks of Royalty
 - 3) "and with a golden sash around his chest"
 - a. Speaks of Righteous Justice
 - b) **Vs 14**
 - 1) "The hairs of his head were white, like white wool, like snow"
 - 2) "His eyes were like a flame of fire"
 - c) Vs 15
 - 1) "His feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace of earth"
 - 2) "his voice was like the roar of many waters"
 - d) **Vs 16**
 - 1) "from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword"
 - a. Ephesians 6:17
 - 2) "In his right hand he held seven stars"
 - a. **Stars** = pastors
 - b. **Right hand** = authority/control
 - 3) "and his face was like the sun shining in full strength."
 - a Matthew 17:2

I. THE ADDRESSEE OF THE LETTER

- 1. Revelation 2:1
 - a) "To the angel"
 - 1) "angel" = messenger, refers to the pastor of the church.
- 2. Ephesus was the most prominent city in Roman Asia Minor.
 - a) It was the most religious and commercial center for that part of the world.
 - b) The Temple of Diana was there.
- 3. Paul established a church in Ephesus on his second missionary journey and later spent 3 years there.
- 4. It is very likely that John the apostle became the head of that church following Timothy's ministry.
- 5. **BIG:** It was while John was living in Ephesus that he was taken captive and exiled to Patmos. Why??? 1:9

II. A DESCRIPTION OF CHRIST GIVEN

- 1. Amazing how when Christ delivers His message to each of the seven churches, He focuses on one of the aspects of His own character.
 - a) Revelation 1:12-18
- 2. Ie. Smyrna Revelation 2:8
 - a) Cf. 1:17-18
 - 1) It is that aspect of Christ's identity that will meet the need of the church in Smyrna.
- 3. To the church of Ephesus Christ is portrayed as "the one who holds the seven stars in his right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands" 2:1

III. THE COMMENDATION OF THE CHURCH

1. Vs 2-3

A. THIS CHURCH WAS AN INFLUENTIAL CHURCH

- 1. This church had a dynamic congregation doing the work of the Lord.
 - a) **Vs 2a**
 - 1) Jesus said "I know your works"
 - 2) Ephesians 2:8-9, 10

- 2. People who understand Grace Biblically serve abundantly.
 - a) The Word of God was spreading throughout Asia as a result of the ministries of this church in Ephesus.
- 3. Way to many Churches spend their whole existence in a maintenance mode instead of a missions mode.
 - a) Acts 19:10

B. THIS CHURCH WAS A COMMITTED CHURCH

- 1. Vs 2
 - a) "your toil and patient endurance"
 - 1) "toil" has to do with working to the point of exhaustion.
 - a. The Ephesians were paying a price to serve the Lord.
 - b. They were exhausted from their labor.
- 2. 2 Samuel 24:24
 - a) King David is an example of service that costs something.

C. THIS CHURCH WAS AN INTOLERANT CHURCH

- 1. This church was committed to values.
- 2. Vs 2
 - a) "and how you cannot bear with those who are evil" WOW
- 3. This church would not tolerate evil within their church.
 - a) This church practiced church discipline!!!
 - 1) Proverbs 6:16-19
 - 2) Romans 16:17-18
 - 3) Matthew 18

D. THIS CHURCH WAS A DISCERNING CHURCH

- 1. Vs 2
 - a) "but have tested those who call themselves apostles"
- 2. **WOW!!!** This church fought hard to have the right theology!!
 - a) Theology simply means Theo (God) Logos (Knowledge)
- 3. Historians tell us that up until about 150AD there were some church leaders who traveled about claiming to have been appointed by one of the twelve original apostles.
- 4. VERY IMPORTANT: The Ephesians would have no part of it!!!
 - a) They barred such apostles from their church.

- 5. Acts 1:21-22
- 6. Vs 6
 - a) "Yet this you have, you hate the works of the Nicolaitans"
 - b) Who were the Nicolaitans??
 - 1) This is not a translation but a transliteration.
 - 2) "Nico" means to conquer
 - 3) "Laitan" English laity
 - c) Nicolaitan means to "conquer the laity"
- 7. Many scholars feel the Nicolaitans advocated a distinction between the clergy and the laity in the early church.
 - a) 1 Peter 2:5; 9

IV. THE PROBLEM WITH THE CHURCH

- 1. Vs 4
- 2. **WOW!!!** To leave your first love is to leave the excitement and devotion you once had.
- 3. That's what happened to the Ephesian church.
 - a) "They abandoned the love they had at first"

V. THE CURE FOR THE CHURCH

A. REMEMBER FROM WHERE YOU HAVE FALLEN

- 1. Vs 5
 - a) "Remember therefore from where you have fallen".
- 2. To Remember is to meditate on what your relationship with Christ was like when you first got saved.

B. REPENT

- 1. Vs 5
 - a) Repenting means changing your mind and turning to go in the opposite direction.
- 2. It's a choice!!! It was a choice to leave!!! It's a choice to go back.
- 3. Vs 5
 - a) "If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place."
