INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The church at Pergamum was the Compromising Church.
- 2. Read Revelation 2:12-17
- 3. Notice Vs 13
 - a) "I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is."

I. BACKGROUND OF THE CHURCH

- 1. Pergamum was the most northern of the seven churches.
 - a) Pergamum had been the capital of Asia for almost 400 years when the letter was written.
- 2. Sir William Mitchell Ramsey was an archaeologist and New Testament scholar.
 - a) By the time he died in 1939 he became the foremost authority of his day on the history of Asia Minor and leading scholar in the study of the New Testament.
 - b) Here's what he had to say: "Beyond all other cities in Asia Minor, it gives the traveler the impression of a royal city, the home of authority. The rocky hill on which it stands is so huge and dominates the plain so proudly and so boldly."
- 3. The library in Pergamum was second to none only to the library in Alexandria Egypt.
 - a) So Pergamum was an intellectual center as well as a center for Roman Authority and prominence.

II. THE JESUS OF PERGAMUM

- 1. Vs 12
 - a) "The words of him who has the sharp two edged sword"
 - b) Cf. 1:16
- 2. The sword represents judgment and King Jesus is prepared to use it on the city of Pergamum if they do not repent.
 - a) 2:16
 - 1) "Therefore repent"

III. THE CHURCH EVALUATION

(Jesus diagnosis of the Pergamum church revealed 4 things)

A. JESUS KNOWS YOUR CIRCUMSTANCES

- 1. Vs 13
 - a) "I **know**"
- 2. Vs 13
 - a) "where you dwell"
 - b) "where Satan's throne is"
 - c) "where Satan dwells"
- 3. "dwell" means to have a permanent address.
 - a) Jesus knew that where they lived; Satan lived.
- 4. Vs 13
 - a)
- 1) "I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is."
- 5. "Asclepius" was the god of healing and was known as the Pergamene god.
 - a) The temples of Asclepius were the nearest things to hospitals in the ancient world.
 - b) The temple of Asclepius was referred to as "Asclepius Soter" or WOW!!!!! "Asclepius the Savior"
- 6. Jesus understood exactly the darkness where the believers were living in Pergamum.
 - a) "Jesus knows"

B. JESUS KNOWS OUR CONVICTIONS

- 1. Vs 13c
 - a) "Yet you hold fast my name"
- 2. Even though they were persecuted, they held fast to their faith.

C. JESUS KNOWS OUR COURAGE

- 1. Vs 13
 - a) "Even in the days of Antipas my faithful witness, who was killed among you."

- 2. Vs 13
 - a) "Antipus my faithful witness"
 - 1) "witness" martyr
- 3. Jesus is referred to as the "Faithful Witness"
 - a) Revelation 1:5; 3:14

D. HE KNOW IF WE COMPROMISE OUR FAITH

- 1. BIG In each of the churches so far, Satan has employed different strategies to try and undermine their witness for Jesus.
 - a) Just as Satan knows our weaknesses and tries to undermine our witness for Jesus.
- 2. Satan's strategies are not random!! They are CALCUATED!!
 - a) In the church at Ephesus his strategy is to remove their love for Christ.
 - b) In the church at Smyrna his strategy was persecution by the Roman Empire.
 - c) NOW in the church at Pergamum Satan is going to try to weaken the church through **COMPROMISE**.

3. THE DOCTRINE OF BALAAM

- a) Numbers 22-25
- b) Balak, king of Moab wanted Israel destroyed.
 - 1) So he went to Balaam and hired him to curse Israel.
 - 2) And every time he opened his mouth to curse Israel.... A BLESSING CAME OUT!!!
- c) So Balaam taught Balak how to put a stumbling block in the path of Israel in the form of enticements from Moabite women.
 - 1) These women enticed Israelite men to take part in idolatrous sacrifices and commit sexual immorality.
 - 2) Numbers 25:1-3
 - 3) In response God killed 24000 Israelites for compromising their faith.
- f) Balaam's Motto: If you can't curse them corrupt them.
- g) So Balaam coveted money and was willing to do anything for it.
 - 1) Including telling someone else how to lead people to sin.
 - 2) 2:14

5. THE DOCTRINE OF THE NICOLAITANS

- a) Revelation 2:6
 - 1) To Conquer the Laity
- b) Creating the clergy/laity division that existed throughout Church history had its beginning with the Nicolaitans.

IV. THE COMMAND TO THE CHURCH

- 1. Vs 16 WOW!!!
 - a) "Repent" change directions
 - b) "If not ... wow

V. THE <u>DELIVERANCE</u> OF THE CHURCH

A. HIDDEN MANNA

- 1. Vs 17
 - a) "I will give some of the hidden Manna"
 - 1) Manna of course was the heavenly food God gave the Israelites to keep them alive in the wilderness.
 - b) As a memorial to God's provision a pot of Manna was kept in the Ark of the Covenant.
- 2. Message: God has food that will sustain them!!!

B. A WHITE STONE

- 1 Vs 17
 - a) "I will give him a white stone, with a new name written on the stone."
- 2. The giving of the white stone not the believer here is the indication that he is accepted by Christ.
 - a) Even though rejected by the world.

VI. COMPROMISE TODAY

- 1. The merging of the church with the world.
- 2. The merging of the believer and the world.
