IMMANUEL-"God With Us"

"Names Mean Something"

Matthew 1:18-25

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. In the Bible NAMES mean something!!
 - a) There are some 85 names of God in the Bible, all to give us a description of Himbecause no one name can define Him!!
- 2. This morning I want to focus on one of those names.
 - a) Matthew 1:23
 - 1) "They shall call His name Immanuel"
 - b) **Vs 22-23**
 - 1) Matthew 1:23 is a fulfillment of Isaiah 7:14
 - 2) "Immanuel" means "God with us"

I. THE PROPHECY

A. THE CONTEXT OF THE PROPHECY

- 1. Matthew 1:23 is a fulfillment of Isaiah 7:14.
 - a) "Immanuel" means "God with us!"
- 2. So what does it mean to call Jesus Immanuel?
- 3. In **Isaiah 7:14** God's people were being attacked by the enemy!!!
 - a) AND God showed up and said to King Ahaz, "I'm going to give you a Sign of Victory."
- 4. The birth prophesied was to be a sign to King Ahaz specifically.
 - a) This child who was to be a sign that Judah would not be conquered by the Israel-Aram alliance, was most likely the son soon to be born to Isaiah and the "prophetess" 8:3
- 5. So one of the things we must understand about Immanuel is that no matter what you are going through, or what you have gone through, (the good, bad, and the ugly), **He is the same Immanuel**.
 - a) He is "God with you."
- 8. So when Matthew quotes the verse *Isaiah 7:14* he does so because things aren't going so well.

B. GOING DEEPER

- 1. The New Testament declares over and over again that Jesus is God.
 - a) Colossians 1:15
 - b) *Hebrews* 1:3
- 2. The Jews wanted to kill Jesus because He made Himself equal to God.
 - a) John 1:1
- 3. The writers of the New Testament declared Jesus to be God.
 - a) John 14:8-9

C. THE NAMES OF JESUS

- 1. In the O.T. Elohim is the creator God
 - a) In the N.T.it says everything that was created was created by Jesus Christ.
- 2. In the O.T. God is called Jehovah the "I AM"
 - a) In the N.T. Jesus said to the Jews "Before Abraham was "I AM"
- 3. In the O.T. God is called Adoni Master over all (The Boss)
 - a) In the N.T. it says we must confess Jesus as Lord (Our Boss)
- 4. In the O.T. God is called **Jehovah Nissi** "Your banner of victory.
 - a) In the N.T. Jesus said "I have overcome the world."
- 5. In the Old Testament God is called Jehovah Rohi the Lord is my Shepherd.
 - a) In the N.T. Jesus said "I am the good Shepherd and my sheep hear my voice.
- 6. In the Old Testament God is Jehovah Tsaba "The Lord of Hosts"
 - a) In the N.T. Jesus could have called 10,000 angels.
- 7. In the O.T. God is called **El Elyon** "The Most High God"
 - a) In the N.T. Jesus sits on the right hand of the Father.
- 8. In the O.T. God is called "El Shaddai" Almighty God
 - a) In the N.T. It says that Jesus is "Lord Almighty" Revelation 1:8
- 9. **VERY GOOD**: So if you get confused about the names of God all you have to do remember the name "**Immanuel**" "God with us"

II. HOW GOD GOT TO BE WITH US

A. HIS NATURE

- 1. Because God is transcendent in nature which means He is Holy Other.
 - a) That is, <u>He is outside of our realm</u> meaning He is infinitely distinct from His creation
- 2. God wanted to be with us dwelling among us.
- 3. So how did this occur? The prophecy tells us.

B. UNION OF TWO NATURES

- 1. Matthew 1:2-3
 - a) "a virgin shall conceive and bear a son"
- 2. So how in the world does this happen?
- 3. It's what's known as the "Hypostatic Union"
 - a) That is the union of 2 natures, in one person, unmixed forever.
- 4. That's why Jesus is sometimes called the **Son of God**, because he has the nature of deity.
 - a) and other times, The **Son of Man**, because he has the nature of humanity.
- 5. How does that occur? A virgin would have a baby.
 - a) Luke 1:30-34, 35
- 6. Philippians 2:6-7
 - a) Before the birth of Jesus, He existed as part of the God-head.
- 7. Isaiah 9:6
 - a) "Unto us a child is born" Christ's humanity
 - b) "unto us a Son is given" Christ's deity.
- 8. Even though a child was born, a son had to be given, WHY?
 - a) Because the Son existed before the child was born..
- 9. Philippians 2:7
 - a) "but he emptied himself"
 - b) "by taking the form of a servant"

- c) "being born in the likeness of men"
- 10. Why did He do that?? So that He could be with us.
 - a) Jesus went through the entirety of human development yet without losing His deity.
- 11. Col 1:16
- 12. Hebrews 10:5-7

III. HEIR TO THE THRONE

- 1. The O.T. prophets, prophesied, that one day a Messiah would come.
 - a) That He would have to become the LEGAL chronological lineage of David.
- 2. WOW!!! The whole O.T. said that a King was coming.
 - a) AND that this king would be God in the flesh.
 - b) AND THAT this king would come through the Tribe of Judah via the lineage of David.
- 3. NOW WATCH THIS: In 70 AD Titus, the Roman General destroyed Jerusalem.
 - a) He destroyed the City as well as the Temple.
 - b) Which is important to know because all the genealogical records of the Jews were located in the temple!!
- 4. There are TWO genealogical lines in Scripture.
 - a) One is the record of Joseph
 - b) AND the other is the record of Mary
- 5. These 2 genealogies PROVE that Jesus was and is the Messiah prophesied in the **OLD TESTAMENT**.
 - a) That Jesus is from the linage of David biologically and legally.
- 6. Matthew 1:6-9, 16
 - a) "by whom"
- 7. So God moved heaven and earth to get them to fall in love and get engaged.
- 8. And then had to get them to Bethlehem Micah 5:2
 - a) So that the prophecy could be fulfilled.
- 9. Luke 2:1-7

10. Hebrews 4:14-16

- a) Jesus felt loneliness, betrayal, crucifixion and death.
- 11. So we could have a personal relationship with Him.
