# THE PERSPECTIVE OF CHRISTMAS Matthew 2:1-8

#### INTRODUCTION

- 1. Christmas is, for a lot of folks.
  - a) They are well-wrapped emptiness.
  - b) Many people find Christmas to be a depressing time.
  - c) And if you do not understand the true meaning of Christmas, you can make it pretty, but it's hollow inside.
- 2. Right now we live in some very difficult times.
  - a) 2 Timothy 3:1-5
    - 1) We are living troubling times but the Christ of Christmas changes everything!!!,
- 3. When God become a man He lived a perfect life, provided Salvation, and now he rules as King of kings and Lord of lords.
- 4. Very Important: It's all about dealing with the sin question.
  - a) You miss that, you miss the reason for Christmas.
- 5. The Christian life is all about PERSPECTIVE!!!
- 6. Matthew 2:1-8
- 7. This morning we will look @ some other personalities in Matthew 2
- I. THE PERSPECTIVE OF THE WISE MEN
  - 1 Matthew 2: 1-2
  - A. THEY CAME TO WORSHIP
    - 1. SO....What is worship?
      - a) Psalm 29:2
    - 2. So what does "worship" mean?
      - a) Answer: It is reverent homage and honor paid to God.
      - b) It is something done or given in acknowledging the WORTH of another.
      - c) The objective of Salvation is to create WORSHIPPERS.
    - 3. WOW!!! Isaiah 35:8-10
      - a) Speaking of Israel and the Millenium!!
    - 4. THIS IS HUGE!! How we worship reflects the hope of our eternal destiny!!!

- a) John 4:23
- 5. I Chronicles 16:23-29
- 6. Psalm 100:1-5

## B. JESUS WAS WORTHY OF THEIR WORSHIP

- 1. Their perspective was Jesus was worth the worship.
  - a) Jesus was worth the inconvenience to get to worship.
- 2. So, they see his star, his star. Not merely a star, his star.
- 3. That means that they looked at the prophecies concerning Jesus as being the revelation of God and decided this child was worthy of worship.
  - a) How did they know what to look for?
- 5. Daniel 2:12-24, 36-45 a) Cf. 5:11-12
- 6. Matt 2:9-11
- 7. "When they reached the house and saw the child," which amounts to a 1-2 year journey if they initiated their journey to Jesus when they saw the star of his birth.
  - a) The Greek word there means "toddler," a 1- or 2-year old.
- 8. WOW!!!!!!!! So, the question you have to ask is does Christmas invoke worship in your life?
  - a) These wise men sought him, and because they sought him, God revealed himself to them.
- 9 Matthew 2:11-12

## C. WORSHIP LEADS TO GUIDANCE

- 1. Guess what they got because they had a divine focus on Christmas?
  - a) They got divine guidance.
- 2. The Magi got divine guidance in their worship, not in the opening of their Christmas gifts, not in their parties, not in their celebrations.

- 3. So if you need to hear from God, it would be wise to spend more time in worship.
- 4. They got guidance because they had worship.
  - a) Wise men still seek him during Christmas. Why?
  - b) Because God is WHERE Jesus is being glorified and worshiped.
- 5. **LISTEN UP**: So because of their great inconvenience to get to Jesus, they got to hear from heaven. AMEN

## II. THE PERSPECTIVE OF KING HEROD

# A. TROUBLED OVER WORSHIP

- 1. Vs 3
  - a) "When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all of Jerusalem with him".
- 2. When Herod the king heard this, what exactly did he hear?
  - a) He heard what the magi were looking for....a King!!
    - 1) "Where is the King of the Jews that we might worship him"?
- 3. And when Herod got shook up, it says all of Jerusalem got shook up with him.
  - a) What was it about what the magi were looking for that messed up Herod?
  - b) They were looking for another king.
  - c) and Herod was the king!!!
- 4. Herod's perspective was. "We don't have room for two kings."
- 5. When Herod is upset you're in trouble!!!!!
- 6. WOW!!!! Jesus ALSO has problems with people who don't want his rule in their life.
  - a) People would rather have a Jesus they can rule over.
  - b) Not a Savior who rules over us.

#### 7. Matthew 2:2

- 8. So here is the question you gotta ask from this lesson of Herod.
  - a) So the wise men believed Jesus was worthy of worship at Christmas!!
    - 1) Even if it was a huge inconvenience.

- b) But here's the question Does Jesus have the right to be King over your life?
- c) And watch this Are other people negatively affected because you do not allow him to rule in your life?
- 9. **This is huge**: WOW!!! A lot of other folk are in trouble because we're in trouble with Jesus being King.
  - a) When a man says, "Jesus can't be king over my life...somebodies in trouble.
  - b) When a society says, "We don't want Jesus and his principles ruling here," that nation is in trouble.

#### 10. Notice Vs 3-4

- 1) Vs 4
  - a) "and he assembling all the chief priests and scribes of the people"
  - b) "he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born"

#### 11. Vs 8

- a) "and when you have found him,"
- b) "bring me word, that I too may come and worship him"
- 12. There's a third group.
  - a) **Vs 4** 
    - 1) It says "I want you to get this information. Where is this Jesus to be born? Where is this King to be born"?

# III. THE PERSPECTIVE OF THE RELIGIOUS

#### 1. Vs 5-6

- 1. Interesting. He calls the religious leaders, and the religious leaders quote Scripture.
- 2. That means they know their Bible.
  - a) While they knew the Bible, they never made the trip.
    - 1) While they knew the Word, they never went a few miles to see  $\mathop{\hbox{\rm Him}}\nolimits.$
- 3. They had studied the Scripture but did not lift a finger to go and worship the Lord.

## 4. John 5:39-40

- a) Jesus tells them that they have the Word and they study the Scriptures, but they did not know the Lord.
- 5. The religious leaders knew the Scriptures, but they didn't go to Jerusalem.
  - a) If the Scriptures don't lead you to Jesus, then you've got a well-wrapped holiday.

#### CONCLUSION:

- 1. Christmas season will be full of religious activities.
  - a) If what you read about him doesn't draw you to him, you don't experience him.
- 2. So, as you interact with yourself and others during this holiday season,
  - a) You don't want to be like Herod reject his rule.
  - b) You don't want to be like the *religious leaders* read his Word, and not move to Him.
  - c) YOU WANT TO BE LIKE THE WISE MEN AND WORSHIP HIM
