THE UNVEILING OF CHRIST

"The Church In Heaven" Revelation 4:1-11

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Revelation 1:19 is the outline of the entire book.
- 2. The scene now in chapter 4 shifts from earth to heaven.

I. WHERE'S THE CHURCH?

- 1. Between Chapter 3 and Chapter 4 we have a change of location of the Church from earth to Heaven.
- 2. QUESTION: How did this happen? The Rapture of the Church!!
- 3. FIVE FACTS HELP US ESTABLISH THIS TRUTH
- A. Fact #1 THE SEQUENCE OF EVENTS
 - 1. Vs 1
 - a) "After this"
 - 2. After what??? 1:19
 - a) "The things which thou hast seen"
 - 1) Chapter 1:1-18
 - 2) A portrait of the glorified Christ.
 - b) "the things which are"
 - 1) Chapters 2 & 3
 - a. The seven churches.
 - c) Therefore "and those that are to take place after this"
 - 1) Sequentially this is after the Church Age.
 - 3. Now look @ the phrase "After this" in 4:1
 - a) "after this" Gk is "meta tauta"
 - b) AND 1:19 "those that are to take place after this"
 - 4. THERE IS A CONNECTION there is a grammatical link between 1:19 and 4:1
 - a) AND John clearly says that Heaven now becomes the focal point.

- 5. Revelation 4:1a
 - a) "After this I looked and behold a door standing open in heaven"

B. Fact# 2 THE ABSENCE OF THE CHURCH ON EARTH

- 1. In Chapters 4-19 the Church is not mentioned one time.
- 2. IF THE CHURCH was on earth during the Tribulation, you would think it would be mentioned.
- 3. Now watch this: A phrase John uses 7 times in chapters 2&3.
 - a) "He who has an ear to hear let him hear what the Spirit says to the Churches."
 - b) Seven times "what the Spirit says to the Churches"
- 4. NOW IN 13:9 deep in the Tribulation period "If anyone has an ear, let him hear"
- 5. Another CLUE that the Church is gone from the earth.
 - a) The name by which Christians refer to God "Father".
 - 1) Matthew 6:9
- 6. AND IN Revelation Chapters 4-19 God is never called "Father".
 - a) During the Tribulation God is referred to as "God", "Lord Almighty", and other names by which He is called in the OLD TESTAMENT.

C. Fact #3 - THE LOCATION OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

- 1. The Hoy Spirit takes up permanent residence in the body of the believer.
 - a) 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
 - b) Romans 8:15-17
- 2. In **Revelation chapters 2-3** the Holy Spirit was in the midst of the Churches on Earth.
- 3. 2 Thessalonians 2:6-8
 - a) Vs 7
 - 1) "Only he who now retrains it will do so until he is out of the way"
- 4. Revelation 4-19 describes a time when, literally, all hell breaks loose upon the earth.

D. Fact #4 - CHECKING PARALLEL PASSAGES

- 1. THE VOICE
 - a) Revelation 4:1
 - 1) Cp. 1 Thessalonians 4:16
- 2. THE TRUMPET OF GOD
 - a) Revelation 4:1
 - 1) Cp. 1 Thessalonians 4:16
 - 2) 1 Corinthians 15:52
- 3. A CHANGE TAKES PLACE
 - a) Revelation 4:2
 - b) 1 Corinthians 15:52-53
- E. Fact #5 JOHN'S CALL TO HEAVEN
 - 1. Revelation 4:1a
 - a) "Come up here"

II. AN INSIDE VIEW OF HEAVEN

- 1. Vs 1
 - a) "a door standing open in Heaven"
- 2. WOW, WOW, WOW
 - a) What did John see??? WORSHIP!!!!!!!!!
 - 1) Worship will be the primary activity in Heaven!!!
- 3. Mark 12:28-31
- 4. The KEY Word in Chapter 4 is "Throne"
- A. WHO IS <u>SEATED</u> ON THE THRONE
 - 1. Vs 2-3
 - 2. Remember God's promise Revelation 1:3.
 - 3. **Vs** 3
 - a) Jasper & Sardine
 - 1) Were the first and last stones on the High Priests breastplate.
 - b) Cf. Exodus 28:15-21

- 1) Jasper Is Crystal Clear like a Diamond
 - a. First stone on the breastplate Represented Reuban Jacobs Firstborn
 - b. means "Behold a son"
- 2) Sardine Deep Dark Ruby Red Color
 - a. The last stone on the breastplate which represented Benjamin Jacobs last born.
 - b. means "son of my right hand"
- 4. Jesus was and is the First and Last...
 - a) Revelation 3:21
 - b) Revelation 1:17

B. THRONE SURROUNDED BY A GREEN RAINBOW

- 1. Vs 3b
 - a) "and around the throne was a rainbow that had the appearance of an emerald"
 - 1) The emerald was green in color Green is the color of life.
- 2. The rainbow takes us back to God's promise of MERCY in Genesis 9:13-16.
 - a) Never to destroy all things again.
- 3. WHILE ALL HELL breaks loose on earth during the Tribulation, the Church is safe in HEAVEN.
 - a) A reminder of God's promise by the Emerald rainbow circling the throne.
- 4. The rainbow provides a balance to the fiery flashings of judgment around God's throne.
 - a) Genesis 9:13-17
 - 1) God's faithfulness mercy and grace.
