#### THE UNVEILING OF JESUS CHRIST

"Philadelphia - The Faithful Church"

#### Revelation 3:7-13

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- 1. The Church of Philadelphia the Church of brotherly love, received a commendation appropriate for a church of overcomers.
- 2. The church of Philadelphia along with the Church of Smyrna were the ONLY 2 of the seven that did not receive condemnation from the Lord.
  - a) In spite of their struggles, the Believers @ Philadelphia were faithful and obedient to the Lord.
  - b) They provide an outstanding model of a loyal Church.

### I. THE <u>RECIPIENTS</u> OF THE LETTER

- 1. The Church of Philadelphia brotherly love!!
- 2. The noun or adjective for of the word is used 7 times in the in the New Testament.
  - a) Romans 12:10
  - b) 1 Thessalonians 4:9
  - c) Hebrews 13:1
  - d) 1 Peter 1:22; 3:8
  - e) 2 Peter 1:7
- 3. The Church of Philadelphia was the youngest of the 7 CITIES.
  - a) Founded sometime after 189 BC either by King Eumenes of Pergamum or his brother, Atalus II, who succeeded him as king.
  - b) The city derived its name from Attalus II's nickname Philadelphus ("brother lover"), which came from his loyalty to his brother Eumenes.

# II. THE DISCRIPTION OF THE LORD

- 1. Vs 7
- 2. Jesus gives a partial description of Himself from the portrait he painted in 1:12-18.
- 3. **Vs 7** again
  - a) "the holy one"
  - b) "the true one"
  - c) "who has the key of David"
- 4. Jesus positions himself as the preeminent, holy God, qualified to call the believers of Philadelphia to life of faith in Him.

- 5.1 Peter 1:15
- 6. The reference to His being true is a reference to His genuineness or reality.
- 7. Vs 7
  - a) "who has the key of David"
- 8. Cf. Isaiah 22:22
  - a) Eliakim foreshadowed Christ the king of truth and holiness as well as opportunity for ministry and service.

### III. THE COMMENDATION FROM THE LORD

- A. THEY HAD A GREAT OPPORTUNITY
  - 1. Vs 7-8
  - 2. So what exactly is an Open Door?
    - a) 1 Corinthians 16:8-9
      - 1) "a wide door" a great opportunity
    - b) 2 Corinthians 2:12
    - c) Colossians 4:3
      - 1) An open door or opportunity to preach the Gospel
  - 3. Philadelphia was the key, the gateway, to the central part of Asia Minor.
  - 4. **Very Important**: So when Jesus spoke to the Church about an open door they were immediately reminded of the history of the city and the opportunity to influence thousands of people.

## B. THEY HAVE LITTLE STRENGTH

- 1. Vs 8
  - a) "I know that you have but little power"
- 2. 2 Corinthians 12:9
- C. COMMENDATION #3 THEY HELD TIGHT TO THE WORD
  - 1. Vs 8
    - a) "yet you have kept my Word"

2. In the midst of a Pagan World, the Church @ Philadelphia believed the Word of God and remained faithful to it.

# D. COMMENDATION #4 - THEY HAVE NOT DENIED THE LORD

- 1. Vs 8
  - a) "and have not denied my name"
- 2. The Church @ Philadelphia remained strong in their belief of the deity of Christ and who He was.
- 3. These 4 commendations are characteristics of growing congregations.
  - a) They have an Open Door great opportunity
  - b) They have "Little Strength"
  - c) They "Hold Tight to God's Word
  - d) They do not Deny Christ

### IV. THE PROMISE OF CHRIST TO THE CHURCH

### A. THEIR ENEMIES WILL BE DEFEATED

- 1. Vs 9
  - a) "I will make those of the Synagogue of Satan"
- 2. These were unbelieving Jews
  - a) 2:9
    - 1) They rejected Jesus as Messiah
- 3. Romans 2:28-29
- 4. Bowing down @ someone's feet depicts total submission.
  - a) The Philadelphian churches enemies would be completely humbed and defeated.
    - 1) Isaiah 45:14
    - 2) Isaiah 49:23
    - 3) Isaiah 60:14

# B. KEPT FROM THE TRIBULATION

- 1. Vs 10
  - a) "I will keep you <u>from</u> (Gk. ek means "out from") the hour of trial that is coming on <u>the whole</u> <u>world</u>"

- 2. This promise has prophetic significance.
- 3. This is not regional tribulation but tribulation on "the whole world".
- 4. This is a time of testing that the Church would be kept from.
  - a) That time of testing is found in Revelation 4-19.
  - b) 1 Corinthians 15:51-54
  - c) 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17
- 5. There are three views of the tribulation period.
  - a) **The Pre-Tribulation View** the Church will be Raptured out before the Tribulation.
  - b) **The Mid-Tribulation View** the Church will be Raptured out in the middle of the Tribulation.
  - c) **The Post-Tribulation View** the Church will go through the Tribulation and then be Raptured out.
- 6. The Church is not mentioned from Chapter 4 on. Not one time.
  - a) But in Chapters 1-3 it is mentioned 19 times.

## C. JESUS PROMISED TO COME SOON

- 1. Vs 11
- 2. I believe you can lose your crowns.
  - a) The Imperishable Crown
    - 1) 1 Corinthians 9:24-25
  - b) The Crown of Rejoicing
    - 1) 1 Thessalonians 2:19
  - c) The Crown of Life
    - 1) Revelation 2:10
  - d) The Crown of Righteousness
    - 1) 2 Timothy 4:8
  - e) The Crown of Glory
    - 1) 1 Peter 5:4-5
