- 3. Vs 13
 - a) "Hosanna" means "Lord Save Us"
- 4. THEY WERE NOT LOOKING FOR SALVATION FROM THEIR SINS
- 5. John 12:32-33
 - a) Vs 32
 - 1) "When I am lifted up" Crucified
- 6. Vs 34 Woe!!! "Wait a minute." "Hold it right there..."
 - a) "What kind of Messiah are you anyway?"
- 7. Isaiah 9:3
 - a) "You have multiplied the nation..."
 - 1) Which means the nation will grow numerically.
 - b) "You have increased its joy" "they rejoice before you"
 - 1) Which means we're all going to be happy.
 - c) "as with joy at the harvest"
 - 1) Stock market is going up.
 - d) "as they are glad, when they divide the spoil"
 - 1) Prosperity, prosperity, prosperity!!!!
- 8. Isaiah 9:4-7
 - a) Exactly Messiah will not die!!!

- 9. NOW Isaiah 53:4-6
 - a) What....???????
- 10. We do the same thing!!!
 - a) Matthew 6:21
 - b) 2 Corinthians 6:14
 - c) Ephesians 5:18
 - d) Ephesians 4:32
 - e) Mark 12:30-31
 - f) Matthew 7:1-5
- 11. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11 WOW
 - a) "revilers" those who use the tongue to berate, tear down another
 - b) "swindlers" a person who cheats or defrauds another person!!!
 - c) "idolator" an idol is anything we love more than God!!!

(Three FACTS about Salvation)

I. FIRST IS THE EXTENT OF SALVATION

- 1. John 12:17
 - a) Vs 18
 - 1) "sign" "semeion" points to something of greater significance
 - b) **Vs 19**
 - 1) "Look the world has gone after Him"
 - 2) Wow...what a prophetic utterance.
- 2 Vs 20
 - a) "Greeks" are Gentiles
- 3 Vs 21
 - a) "So these came to Philip"
 - 1) Why?
- 4. There were 2 kinds of Gentiles who came to worship:
 - a) First were the **Proselytes**
 - 1) Were Gentile converts who became Jewish in every way.
 - a. They were circumcised
 - b. They kept all the dietary laws
 - c. They went to the Temple on a regular basis
 - d. Observed all the feasts and festivals
 - 2) Image Court of the Gentiles

- b) The second Group were "God Fearers"
- 5. Vs 21b
 - a) "Sir we wish to see Jesus"
- 6. Vs 22
- 7. Vs 23
 - a) "The hour has come"
 - 1) 2:4; 7:30; 8:20; 7:6,8
 - b) His time is immanent.
 - 1) Vs 27; 13:1; 16:32; 17:1
- 8. Vs 24a
 - a) "Truly, truly, I say unto you"
 - b) "Unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies"
 - 1) And everybody knew exactly what Jesus meant.
 - c) "it remains alone"
 - d) "but if it dies, it bears much fruit"
- 9. Jesus is saying that when He dies and is raised up from the dead, He will bare much fruit. John 12:32
- 10. Now that's THE EXTENT OF SALVATION "for whosoever will"
 - a) Romans 10:13
 - b) 1 Timothy 2:3-4
 - c) 2 Peter 3:9

II. NOW - THE EXPECTATION OF THE SAVED

- 1. Wow!!! Jesus had to die so that you can be saved!!!
- 2. AND NOW Jesus has an expectation of you!!!!!
- 3. **Vs 25a**
 - a) "Whoever loves his life"
 - 1) Gk "psuche" refers to the intellect, emotion and will!!!
 - b) "...loses it"
 - 1) Now that is totally against our *narcissistic* culture.
- 4. The fastest growing religion in the world is the religion of "Self-Worship".
 - a) We are a society of "self-worshippers"
 - 1) We worship at the altar of materialism.

- 2) We worship at the altar of Pride and ego.
- 5. Vs 25a
 - a) "Whoever loves his life loses it"
- 6. Jesus is talking about the requirement of Salvation.
 - a) The one who loves his life in this world by preferring it over the interests of God's kingdom, will ultimately lose it.
- 7. On the other hand: Vs 25b
 - a) "and whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life"
- 8. The word life is used 3 times in vs 25
 - a) "life" gk = "psuche" psyche
 - b) 1 John 2:15-17
- 9. Vs 25
- 10. Galatians 5:19-21

III. FINALLY AN EXPLANATION OF A SERVANT

- 1. Vs 26
 - a) "follow me" means there's a union, companionship, it means to attach
- 2. Jesus said, "If you love me...."
- 3. 1 John 2:6
- 4. True salvation is affection and direction.
- 5. **WOW!!!** It is possible to serve but not be following Jesus.
 - a) Matthew 7:21-23
- 6. WARNING: To be saved is to have a personal relationship with Jesus.
 - a) You are not saved by what you do, but by who you know!!!!
- 7. Vs 26 There are 2 promises
 - a) A promise of heaven "and where I am, there will my servant be also"
 - b) A promise of honor "If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him" (privileges, and blessings)
