PALM SUNDAY 2024

"Which Jesus Do You Want?" John 12:9-19

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. When we come to John chapter 12 we Jesus Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem.
- 2. Vs 1a
 - a) "Six days before Passover"
 - 1) This is the beginning of Passion Week.
 - 2) Events from Palm Sunday to Resurrection Sunday Chart
- 3. John leads us through 3 Passovers in the Gospel.
 - a) It is no accident because shows us that Jesus is the Passover Lamb.
 - b) The 3rd Passover John records takes place the night before Jesus died!!
- 4. What is Passover?
 - a) Passover was a Jewish festival commemorating the Exodus of the Jews from Egypt.
 - 1) Exodus 11-12
- 5. Vs 1b
 - a) "Jesus therefore came to Bethany...where Lazarus was..."
 - b) "whom Jesus raised from the dead"
- 6. Vs 9a
 - a) "Then a Large crowd of the Jews learned that Jesus was there."
- 7. The Jewish people were looking and waiting for their Messiah and this must be Him.
 - a) Since it was Passover there must have been close to a million people in Jerusalem to celebrate.
 - 1) Historian Josephus estimates around 2 million people were there.
 - b) There were 3 festivals in Jerusalem that you did not want to miss.
 - 1) Passover
 - 2) Pentecost
 - 3) Feast of Tabernacles
- 8. Vs 9b
- 9. This was a Passover you did not want to miss; because Lazarus is alive and the one who raised him is going to be there.
- 10. If someone could raise a man from the dead surely this was God's Messiah.

11. BUT HERE'S WHAT'S SAD: <u>God sends His answer to man's situation, and man doesn't</u> like the answer God sends.

I. THE <u>ANTICIPATION</u> OF THE KING WE <u>WANT</u>

- 1. This massive crowd has gathered in anticipation of their Messiah.
- 2. Vs 12
- 3. Vs 13
 - a) "they took branches of Palm trees"
- 4. Chapter 10:22
 - a) "Feast of Dedication"
 - 1) It originated during the "Inter-Testamental" period around 170 BC.
 - 2) During this time there was a Syrian King by the name of Antiochus Epiphanes who was in power.
 - 3) His goal was to Hellenize the Jews; that is to impose Greek Culture on them.
 - 4) He marched into Israel and killed about 40,000 Jews and took another 40,000 of them captive and sold them into slavery.
 - 5) Then he went into the Temple and sacrificed a Pig on the altar thereby desecrating the temple and even erected an altar of Zeus in the most Holy Place.
 - b) Because of this intense persecution, **pious Jews** led by a priest by the name of Mattathias and his son **Judas Maccabeus** revolted.
- 5. Vs 13
 - a) "and they took branches of Palm trees and went out to meet him, crying out, 'Hosanna!"
 - b) "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord"
 - 1) Psalm 118:25-26 WOW!!!!
 - c) Psalms 113-118 are Psalms that speak of Israel' deliverance.
- 6. Psalm 118:19
- 7. Psalm 118:25
 - a) "LORD, save us!!" Hosanna!!!
- 8. Luke 19:41-42

9. Ephesians 4:30

II. THE <u>DEMONSTRATION</u> OF THE KING WHO <u>IS</u>

- 1. Vs 14-15
 - a) "Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it"
 - 1) This is huge!!!!
- 2. We are looking at Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem.
 - a) But there was another Grand Procession that came to that city.
- 3. It was the procession of **Pontius Pilot**.
 - a) He came to the city from the west from Caesaria which is in the north where he resided.
 - b) His job was to keep watch over the Jews and keep them in subjection to Rome.
- 4. When Pilot come he comes with a display of power.
- 5. Zechariah 9:9
- 6. Jesus came the first time in humility because man's greatest need is Salvation.
 - a) When Jesus come the second time He will be on a War Horse.
 - 1) Revelation 19:11ff

III. THE CONFIRMATION OF THE KING WE GET

- 1 Vs 16a
 - a) "His disciples did not understand these things at first"
- 2 Vs 16b
 - a) "but when Jesus was glorified"
 - 1) John 14:26, 16:13
 - b) "then they remembered that these things had been written about Him and had been done to him."
- 3. Jesus was a King like no other.
 - a) Instead of defeating His enemies by force, He conquered them by dying.
 - 1) Ephesians 1:19-22
 - 2) Colossians 2:15

- 5. Vs 18
 - a) "because the Lord had done this sign"
 - b) John 8:31
- 6. Vs 19
 - a) "So the Pharisees said to one another, "You see you are gaining nothing."
 - b) "Look, the world has gone after Him."

CONCLUSION:

- 1. The world's greatest need is not a **political** solution.
- 2. The world's greatest need is not a **financial** solution.
- 3. THE WORLD'S GREATEST NEED IS A SPIRITUAL SOLUTION.
 - a) A relationship with Jesus!!
