INTRODUCTION:

1. Luke 21:25-28

a) Jesus is telling His followers that when they see the beginning of the end, they should pay attention, they should look up!!! Because the end is near.

2. Vs 26

a) "fear" - Gk. Phobos = is also translated "terrified"

3. Vs 28

a) "redemption" - a releasing, for (on payment of) a ransom

I. WHERE WE ARE IN HISTORY - SIX SUPER SIGNS OF PROPHECY

A. ISRAEL BECAME A NATION

1. Isaiah 11:11-12

a) Israel is the only nation that has been dispossessed twice and come back to be a nation.

1) The first time was around 579 BC when the Babylonians conquered Israel and took them physically out of the land back to Babylon.

a. Then 70 years later they were able to return for the first time. (Recorded in Ezra and Nehemiah)
2) The second time was in AD 70, 37 years after Jesus resurrection

the Roman army under Titus killed over a million Jews, destroyed Jerusalem, destroyed the Temple mount and temple and took the remaining Jews captive and dispersed them around the world.

a. BUT in 1948 they were brought back from the FOUR CORNERS of the world for the second time.

B. PROPHETIC FULFILLMENT #2 - "Israel Would Be Reborn in One Day"

1. Isaiah 66:7-8

a) On May 14,1948 the British mandate over Palestine ended .

1) David Ben-Guron served as Israel's first Prime Minister and he declared Israel's Independence.

b) On that day our president, Harry Truman recognized Israel as a nation and other nations did as well!!!

1. Luke 21:20-24

a) When Jesus is talking about Israel being surrounded by army's He is referring to 70 AD when Titus defeated Israel.

2. That was fulfilled on June 5th of 1967.

3. Very Important: When Israel regained Israel in 1948 they didn't get all of Jerusalem.

- a) They only got west Jerusalem.
- b) They did not get East Jerusalem.

D. **PROPHETIC FULFILLMENT #4** - Russian Jews Immigrate to Israel (takes place in 1989)

- 1. Jeremiah 16:14-15 (WOW)
 - a) Prophecy repeated
- 2. Jeremiah 31:7-9
- 3. In 1989 the Iron Curtain fell.
 a) The old Soviet Union wouldn't allow anyone to leave the country very repressive.
- E. PROPHETIC FUFILLMENT #5 Explosion Of Knowledge and Travel (2000-NOW)
 - 1. Daniel 12:1-4 Turn to
 - The book of Daniel is one of the most prophetic books in the Bible.
 a) It is an End Times prophetic book.

3. Daniel 12:4

- a) "when many will rush here and there"
- b) "and knowledge will increase"
- 5. **LISTEN UP**: First is the mode of travel.
 - a) Illustration: My grandfather Maffley was born in 1900. Ouch
 1) When my Grandfather was born the mode of transportation was horse and buggy.
 - 2) When I was born in 1957 We had the "57 Chevy"
 - b) The Evolution of travel.
- 6. Vs 4
 - a) "when many will rush here and there"

7. AND KNOWLEDGE WILL INCREASE

a) Up until 1900 knowledge doubled about every 100 years.

b) @ the end of WW2 knowledge doubled every 25 years.

c) NOW!!! Knowledge doubles every 2 months.

8. The Significance of AI.

b) The united States of America has orders 1000 AI driven F15 fighter planes.

1. 2 Thessalonians 2:1-4

a) **Vs 3**

- 1) "For that day will not, unless the rebellion comes first"
- 2) "rebellion" apostacy to fall away from a position you once held.

2. We are seeing a complete rejection of sound doctrine in many denominations and the acceptance of things God clearly condemns.
